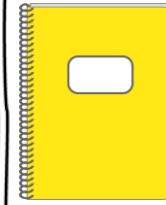


The FFA portion of the grade is evaluated by participation in 3 FFA leadership development events per semester. Students are required take part in a Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) project that nets at least 10 hrs of work and complete the FFA Record Book.

FFA
